Isolated Students' Scholarships and Bursaries

1. General Information

- (a) These Scholarships and Bursaries are awarded annually to students entering Year 7 to 10. They run for three to six years depending on the Year level at entry.
- (b) The Scholarships are worth up to 50% remission of tuition fees.
- (c) The Bursaries are worth 25% remission of tuition fees.
- (d) The recipients will be boarders at Pembroke School, and will be expected to play a full role in the life of the School. If the student ceases to be a boarder, the Scholarship/Bursary ceases from the date of leaving the boarding house.
- (e) Candidates cannot be in receipt of any other School Scholarship or Bursary while they receive either the Isolated Students' Scholarship or Bursary.

2. Selection Criteria

- (a) Students must be entering Year 7 to 10 and eligible to receive Centrelink AIC Boarding Allowance. Priority will be given to students currently enrolled at School of the Air.
- (b) Candidates will have a consistent record of academic progress.
- (c) Candidates will be able and willing to contribute widely to the School's co-curricular program.
- (d) Candidates considering enrolling at Pembroke are welcome to apply.

3. Selection Procedures

- (a) Application forms, obtainable from the School website, will require the following information:
 - (i) name and personal details
 - (ii) a statement of academic record and other relevant information, with documentation
 - (iii) a written reference from at least one person well known by the family and the student.
 - (iv) Please submit a handwritten letter outlining your reasons for applying for a scholarship at Pembroke. We encourage you to reflect on how your personal values and character align with the values of our School and share information about your goals, motivations, and any aspirations that are important to you.
- (b) Applications will close 4pm Wednesday 1 October 2025.
- (c) Short-listed candidates for the Isolated Students' Scholarships will be invited to an interview with the Principal. All candidates are invited to visit and tour the School when visiting Adelaide. Interviews will be scheduled for **November 2025**
- (d) Candidates who are unsuccessful in their application for the Isolated Students' Scholarships are automatically considered for the Isolated Students' Bursaries. There are no interviews for the Isolated Students' Bursaries.
- (e) Offers for both the Isolated Students' Scholarships and Bursaries will be made to the successful candidates by early **December 2025**.
