Scholarships for Boarding Students

1. General Information

- (a) These Scholarships are awarded annually. They run for two to six years depending on the Year level at entry Years 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 to 12 inclusive.
- (b) The Scholarships are worth 50% remission of tuition fees.
- (c) The recipients will be boarders at Pembroke School, and will be expected to play a full role in the life of the School. If the student ceases to be a boarder, the Scholarship concludes from the date of leaving the boarding house.
- (d) Preference will be given to non-metropolitan residents of all Australian states or residents of the Northern Territory.
- (e) Metropolitan residents of Australia and Australian Citizens/Permanent Residents of Australia who reside overseas are also invited to apply for Boarding Scholarships.

2. Selection Criteria

- (a) Candidates will have a consistent record of sound academic achievement.
- (b) Candidates will be able and willing to contribute widely to the School's co-curricular program and will be already recognised contributors to activities in their local area.
- (c) Students currently attending Pembroke, as well as those considering enrolment are welcome to apply.

3. Selection Procedures

- (a) Application forms, obtainable from the School website, will require the following information:
 - (i) name and personal details
 - (ii) a statement of academic record and other relevant academic achievements
 - (iii) evidence of involvement both in School and the community in other relevant activities, such as sport, music, drama
 - (iv) a written reference from one person well known by the family and the student.
 - (v) Please submit a handwritten letter outlining your reasons for applying for ascholarship at Pembroke. We encourage you to reflect on how your personal values and character align with the values of our School and share information about your goals, motivations, and any aspirations that are important to you.
- (b) Applicants will be considered upon receipt of application.
- (c) Short-listed candidates will be invited to come to Pembroke School for an interview with the Principal, as well as being given a tour of the School. Interviews can also be accommodated via video conference.
