Instrumental Music Tuition

Individual Music Tuition with private teachers is available to all students and is a prerequisite for participation in most Pembroke Junior and Middle School ensembles. Specialist tuition is currently offered on the following instruments:

- **Brass** – Euphonium; French Horn; Trombone; Trumpet; Tuba
- **Guitar** – Acoustic (Classical); Bass; Electric
- **Percussion** – Classical Percussion (inc. Mallets); Drum Kit (Jazz & Contemporary)
- **Piano** – Classical; Contemporary; Jazz
- **String** – Cello; Double Bass; Viola; Violin
- **Voice** – Classical; Contemporary; Jazz
- **Woodwind** – Bassoon; Clarinet; Flute; Oboe; Saxophone
- **World Instruments** – Erhu (Chinese Violin)

Ensembles

Students currently learning an instrument are encouraged to engage with a diverse range of co-curricular ensembles to further their technical and artistic skills, deepen musical literacy and broaden friendships. An active calendar of performances offers a variety of opportunities on campus, at prestigious concert venues in Adelaide and through participation in external events such as Generations in Jazz, OzAsia and the ABODA Music Festival. Our current ensemble programs are:

- **Classical and Traditional Ensembles** – Brass Ensemble; Chamber Choir; Junior & Middle School Concert Bands; Junior, Middle & Senior School Guitar Ensembles; Junior, Middle & Senior School Percussion Ensembles; Junior, Middle & Senior School String Ensembles; Middle & Senior School Saxophone Ensembles; Pembroke School Orchestra; Pembroke School Wind Ensemble; Songbirds Choir (Junior School); String Chamber Ensembles; Wind Chamber Ensembles
- **Contemporary Ensembles** – Cantabile Choir (Junior School); Concert Choir; Junior, Middle & Senior School Rock Bands
- **Jazz Ensembles** – Big Band 1; Big Band 2; Big Band 3; Jazz Choir; Small Jazz Ensembles
- **World Ensembles** – Chinese Orchestra

Immersion Program

Pembroke School offers two Immersion Programs for Junior School students to learn music through instrumental performance. Guided by specialist tutors, students receive weekly tuition to gain technical, musical and ensemble skills specific to one instrument across a semester of study.

Year 2 String Immersion Program: Students are offered tuition on either Cello, Double Bass, Viola or Violin.

Year 4 Band Immersion Program: Students are offered tuition on either Clarinet, Flute, Horn, Trombone or Trumpet.

Scholarships

Pembroke offers a limited number of scholarships to students who display excellence in music performance. Music Scholars are expected to make a significant contribution to the musical life of the School, in both the Music classroom and as part of the ensemble programs. Scholarships are offered for students studying Brass, Guitar, Percussion, Piano, String and Woodwind instruments, and Choral Singers.
