

Pembroke

The Margaret Sellars Scholarship is named in honour of Mrs. M. H. Bennett (nee Sellars), Girton Old Scholar 1934 – 1939, Patron of the Pembroke School Foundation and Life Member of the School.

The 2022 Margaret Sellars Scholarship is advertised in conjunction with the Indulkaninna Foundation Scholarship, established by a Pembroke old scholar family.

Eligibility

- **New** students are eligible for both the Margaret Sellars Scholarship and the Indulkaninna Foundation Scholarship. Please note, the awarding of one or dual scholarships is at the Principal's discretion.
- **Existing** Pembroke students are eligible for the Indulkaninna Foundation Scholarship ONLY.

Margaret Sellars Scholarship

Background

Mrs Bennett generously endowed a scholarship for students from rural primary producing communities to attend Pembroke School as full time boarding students, the recipients being students who may not otherwise consider attending Pembroke School.

1. Essential Criteria

- (a) Applicants must be Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia, within the meaning of the Australian Citizenship Act 2006.
- (b) Applicants must be seeking enrolment at Pembroke in Years 10, 11 or 12 in 2022. Existing Pembroke students are **not** eligible.
- (c) Candidates must live in a rural area in South Australia or interstate.
- (d) Candidates will be from families whose principal income is derived from primary producing or allied industries.
- (e) The recipients will become boarders at Pembroke School following entry and are expected to play a full role in the life of the School. If the student ceases to be a boarder, the Scholarship concludes from the date of leaving the boarding house.

2. Selection Criteria

- (a) This Scholarship is awarded at the discretion of the Principal, with priority given on the basis of need.
- (b) Candidates will have a consistent record of sound academic achievement, attendance and community service.
- (c) Candidates will be able and willing to contribute widely to the School's co-curricular programme and will be already recognised contributors to community service with educational objectives.

3 General Information

The value of the Scholarship is determined and offered at the Principal's discretion. It is possible to be awarded a Scholarship equivalent to 100% remission of tuition and a percentage of boarding fees for up to three years depending on the year level at entry.

The Indulkannina Foundation Scholarship

Background

The Indulkannina Foundation Scholarship was established by a Pembroke old scholar family.

1. Essential Criteria

- (a) Applicants must be Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia, within the meaning of the Australian Citizenship Act 2006.
- (b) Applicants must be seeking to enter Years 10, 11 or 12 at Pembroke in 2022 (or other year level in exceptional circumstances and pending agreement between the School and donor). Both new and existing students are welcome to apply.
- (c) The recipients will become boarders at Pembroke School following entry and are expected to play a full role in the life of the School. If the student ceases to be a boarder, the Schoolarship concludes from the date of leaving the boarding house.

2. Selection Criteria

- (a) This Scholarship is awarded at the discretion of the Principal, with priority given on the basis of need.
- (b) Preference will be given to students whose principal residence is at least 56km from the nearest school offering entry at Year 10, 11 and 12.
- (c) Candidates will have a consistent record of sound academic achievement, attendance and community service.
- (d) Candidates will be able and willing to contribute widely to the School's co-curricular programme and will be already recognised contributors to community service with educational objectives.

3. General Information

The value of the Scholarship is a remission on Pembroke boarding fees up to an annual value of \$25,000 for the duration of the recipient's schooling at Pembroke.

Application Information – The Margaret Sellars Scholarship and the Indulkannina Foundation Scholarship

- (a) The School will advertise on the School website when scholarships are to be offered.
- (b) Application forms, obtainable from the School website, will require the following information:
 - · name and personal details
 - a statement of academic record and other relevant academic achievements
 - evidence of involvement both in school and the community in other relevant activities, such as sport, music, drama
 - a written reference from one person known well by the family and the student
 - · an optional Statement of Financial Affairs
- (c) Short-listed candidates will be invited to come to Pembroke School for an interview with the Principal as well as being given a tour of the School.
- (d) Applicants will be notified as soon as possible regarding the outcome.
