
Our congratulations are also extended to the dedicated staff of Pembroke and other Schools who have taught these students over the years, as well as to parents!

2011 SACE ACHIEVEMENT GRADE SUMMARY




Subject Merits

2011 SACE ACHIEVEMENT GRADE DISTRIBUTION




International Baccalaureate

We would like to congratulate the graduating IB class of 2011, our largest to date, and to celebrate our first bilingual Diploma in English, German (and Spanish *ab initio*).

- One student attained a perfect score of 45/45
- There were 61 merits for perfect scores of 7/7 across 19 subjects
- Two students achieved an ATAR of 99.95 and the average ATAR of the cohort was 95.2

Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) Combined SACE and IB

Although Australian States and Territories have different Year 12 Certificate requirements, all student results are converted to a common, Australia-wide scale through the ATAR. This rank, on a scale of 99.95 – 0, is used for university entry nationwide. Our 2011 results on this scale were impressive:

- 20 students (9.2% of year level) achieved an ATAR of 99 or higher (top 1%)
- 83 students (38.2% of year level) achieved an ATAR of 95 or higher (top 5%)
- 127 students (58.5% of year level) achieved an ATAR of 90 or higher (top 10%)
- 169 students (77.7% of year level) achieved an ATAR of 80 or higher (top 20%)
