Results for both of our academic programmes: The South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) and the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBD) are summarised in this brochure as well as details of the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR).



Many have achieved personal best results and their commitment to their senior studies deserves special commendation. Our congratulations are also extended to the dedicated staff of Pembroke and other Schools who have taught these students over the years, as well as to parents!

South Australian Certificate of Education

We would like to acknowledge the following student achievements in the SACE:

- Our SACE Dux was awarded a Governor of South Australia Commendation, one of only 26 awarded in the State, for outstanding overall achievement in the SACE.
 He graduated with 6 subject merits.
- Three SACE students attained an ATAR of 99.95, the highest possible, and two included their first year university studies in Mathematics as part of their ATAR.
- Three other students who also studied German or Mathematics at The University of Adelaide used their tertiary results to contribute significantly towards their impressive ATAR scores.
- 55 subject merits were awarded across 20 subjects.
- Several students graduated with multiple subject merits:
 6 merits (1 student);
 5 merits (1 student);
 4 merits (2 students);
 3 merits (4 students).
- 11 students completed a VET Certificate III qualification which can count towards their ATAR.




Subject Merits

2014 SACE SUBJECT ACHIEVEMENT GRADE DISTRIBUTION




International Baccalaureate Diploma

Congratulations to our 2014 IB Diploma graduates! 48 students graduated with their Diploma and our highest score was 44 / 45.

- Four students received an ATAR of 99.95
- Thirteen students achieved Certificates of Distinction in their Diploma with scores of 40 +.
- · There were 78 subject merits awarded across 21 subjects.
- The average Diploma score was 36.
- Five SACE students studied an IB Language Certificate course which counted towards their SACE and six Year 11 students gained merits in Mathematics SL Anticipated to round out their accelerated Mathematics programme.

2014 IB DIPLOMA SUBJECT GRADE DISTRIBUTION




Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) Combined SACE and IBD

Although Australian States and Territories have different Year 12 Certificate requirements, all student results are converted to a common, Australia-wide scale through the ATAR. This rank, on a scale of 99.95 – 0, is used for university entry nationwide. Our 2014 results on this scale were most pleasing:

- Seven students achieved an ATAR of 99.95: three in SACE and four in IB Diploma.
- 21 students (10.3% of year level) achieved an ATAR of 99+
- 71 students (35% of year level) achieved an ATAR of 95+
- 112 students (55% of year level) achieved an ATAR of 90+.
- 155 students (76.3% of year level) achieved an ATAR of 80+ or higher.
