

#### South Australian Certificate of Education


We would like to acknowledge the following student achievements in the SACE:

- Our SACE Dux was awarded a Governor of South Australia Commendation, one of only 29 awarded in the State for outstanding achievement in the SACE. He graduated with 4 subject merits and A grades in all 8 subjects.
- One SACE student attained an ATAR of 99.95, the highest possible and included her first year university studies in Mathematics as part of her ATAR.
- Three other students who also studied Mathematics at The University of Adelaide used their tertiary results to contribute significantly towards their impressive ATAR scores.
- 39 subject merits were awarded across 20 subjects (one studied externally).
- Several students graduated with multiple subject merits: 4 Merits (2 students); 3 merits (4 students) and 2 merits (4 students).
- 21 students completed a VET Certificate III qualification, which can count towards their ATAR.



# International Baccalaureate Diploma

Congratulations to our second largest cohort of IB Diploma graduates to date! 58 students graduated with their Diploma and our highest score was 44/45.

- Four students received an ATAR of 99.95.
- Fifteen students achieved Certificates of Distinction in their Diploma with scores of 40+.
- There were 74 subject merits awarded across 24 subjects.
- The average Diploma score was 37, an increase on the previous two years.

#### 2013 IB DIPLOMA SUBJECT GRADE SUMMARY




# Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) Combined SACE and IBD

Although Australian States and Territories have different Year 12 Certificate requirements, all student results are converted to a common, Australia-wide scale through the ATAR. This rank, on a scale of 99.95 – o, is used for university entry nationwide. Our 2013 results on this scale were impressive:

- Five students achieved an ATAR of 99.95: one in SACE and four in IB Diploma.
- 21 students (9.2% of year level) were in the top 1% with an ATAR of 99+.
- 85 students (37.2% of year level) were in the top 5% with an ATAR of 95+.
- 130 students (57% of year level) were in the top 10% with an ATAR of 90+.
- 168 students (73.6% of year level) were in the top 20% with an ATAR of 80+.
