Academic Scholarships

1. Scholarship Overview

Pembroke School Academic Scholarships recognise students who demonstrate outstanding academic achievement, intellectual curiosity and a genuine commitment to learning.

Academic Scholars are expected to embrace the opportunities available through a broad and challenging education, while making a positive contribution to the academic, co-curricular and community life of the School. The Scholarship recognises students who not only excel academically but who also demonstrate the character, curiosity and aspiration to contribute meaningfully to the Pembroke community.

2. Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be seeking entry into Year 7 in the designated year in which Academic Scholarships are offered
- Be a new or current Pembroke student, as specified for the relevant Scholarship round
- Register to sit the Academic Assessment Services (AAS) Scholarship Test

Details of available entry year levels, application timelines and assessment dates are published annually.

3. Selection Criteria

In assessing applications, consideration will be given to the applicant's:

- Demonstrated academic achievement and capacity for high-level learning
- Intellectual curiosity, critical thinking and enthusiasm for learning
- Personal qualities including integrity, resilience, responsibility and alignment with the values of Pembroke School
- Contribution to school and community life through leadership, service and co-curricular involvement
- Willingness to contribute positively to the academic, co-curricular and community life of Pembroke School
- Overall alignment with the purpose of the Scholarship

4. Scholarship Value

Academic Scholarships provide up to **100% remission** of tuition fees for the duration of the Scholarship, subject to the Conditions of the Scholarship.

Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion. The value and duration of each Scholarship may vary according to the individual circumstances of the recipient and the purpose of the Scholarship.



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5. Conditions of the Scholarship

To retain the Scholarship, Academic Scholars must:

- Maintain a strong academic standard and engagement in their studies
- Demonstrate a sustained commitment to learning and academic excellence
- Uphold the values and expectations of Pembroke School
- Contribute positively to the academic, co-curricular and community life of the School
- Maintain satisfactory attendance
- Comply with the School's policies and expectations
- Continue to meet any Scholarship-specific requirements

Scholarships are reviewed annually. Continuation is subject to the Academic Scholar continuing to meet these conditions and remains at the Principal's discretion.

6. Assessment Process

Applicants are required to register directly with **Academic Assessment Services (AAS)** to complete the Academic Scholarship Test.

Following the release of the AAS results, Pembroke will review each applicant's assessment outcomes. Shortlisted applicants will be invited to an interview with the Principal and nominated members of the School's Leadership Team.

The final Scholarship decision is based on a holistic assessment of the applicant, taking into consideration their Academic Scholarship Test results, interview and alignment with the Scholarship selection criteria.

Applicants will be advised of the outcome following completion of the selection process.
