Pembroke Community Scholarship

1. Scholarship Overview

The Pembroke Community Scholarship was established through the generosity of the Pembroke community to increase access to an outstanding independent education for students who demonstrate strong academic potential, personal character and a commitment to contributing positively to the life of the School.

The Scholarship supports students who would otherwise be unable to access the opportunities of a Pembroke education due to financial hardship or significant personal circumstances.

2. Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be an Australian citizen or permanent resident of Australia
- Be seeking entry into Year 10, Year 11 or Year 12 at Pembroke School
- Be a new student to Pembroke School

3. Selection Criteria

In assessing applications, consideration will be given to the applicant's:

- Demonstrated commitment to learning and consistent academic progress
- Personal qualities including integrity, resilience, responsibility and alignment with the values of Pembroke School
- Contribution to school and community life through leadership, service and co-curricular involvement
- Willingness to contribute positively to the academic, co-curricular and community life of Pembroke School
- Overall alignment with the purpose of the Scholarship

4. Considerations

The Pembroke Community Scholarship was established to increase access to a Pembroke education for students who demonstrate the qualities sought by the School but would otherwise be unable to enrol due to financial hardship or significant personal circumstances.

In addition to the selection criteria outlined above, consideration will be given to applicants who can demonstrate that financial assistance is essential to accepting and maintaining a place at Pembroke School.

Where applicable, applicants may be asked to provide information to assist the School in assessing eligibility for this Scholarship.



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5. Scholarship Value

The Scholarship provides up to 100% remission of tuition fees for the duration of the Scholarship, subject to the Conditions of the Scholarship.

Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion. The value and duration of each Scholarship may vary according to the individual circumstances of the recipient and the purpose of the Scholarship.

6. Conditions of the Scholarship

To retain the Scholarship, recipients must:

- Maintain a strong academic standard and engagement in their studies
- Uphold the values and expectations of Pembroke School
- Contribute positively to the academic, co-curricular and community life of the School
- Maintain satisfactory attendance
- Comply with the School's policies and expectations
- Continue to meet any Scholarship-specific requirements

Scholarships are reviewed annually. Continuation is subject to the recipient continuing to meet these conditions and remains at the Principal's discretion.

7. Assessment Process

Applications are submitted through the Pembroke School online Scholarship application form.

Shortlisted applicants may be invited to an interview with the Principal or a nominated member of the School's Leadership Team.

Applicants will be advised of the outcome following completion of the selection process.
