Scholarships for Boarding Students

1. Scholarship Overview

Pembroke School offers Boarding Scholarships to recognise students who demonstrate strong academic potential, personal character and a commitment to contributing positively to the life of the School.

Boarding Scholarships provide opportunities for students from across Australia to benefit from a Pembroke education while becoming active members of the School's Boarding community.

2. Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be seeking entry into Years 7 to 11 at Pembroke School
- Be a new or current Pembroke student
- Become a boarder at Pembroke School upon commencement

Preference may be given to applicants from regional and rural Australia. Applications are also welcomed from metropolitan students and students residing overseas.

3. Selection Criteria

In assessing applications, consideration will be given to the applicant's:

- Demonstrated commitment to learning and consistent academic progress
- Personal qualities including integrity, resilience, responsibility and alignment with the values of Pembroke School
- Contribution to school and community life through leadership, service and co-curricular involvement
- Willingness to contribute positively to the academic, co-curricular and boarding life of Pembroke School
- Overall alignment with the purpose of the Scholarship

4. Scholarship Value

Boarding Scholarships provide a remission of **50% of tuition fees** for the duration of the Scholarship, subject to the Conditions of the Scholarship.

Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion. The value and duration of each Scholarship may vary according to the individual circumstances of the recipient and the purpose of the Scholarship.



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5. Conditions of the Scholarship

To retain the Scholarship, recipients must:

- Maintain a strong academic standard and engagement in their studies
- Uphold the values and expectations of Pembroke School
- Contribute positively to the academic, co-curricular and boarding life of the School
- Remain enrolled as a boarder at Pembroke School
- Maintain satisfactory attendance
- Comply with the School's policies and expectations
- Continue to meet any Scholarship-specific requirements

Scholarships are reviewed annually. Continuation is subject to the recipient continuing to meet these conditions and remains at the Principal's discretion.

6. Assessment Process

Applications are submitted through the Pembroke School online Scholarship application form.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to an interview with the Principal or a nominated member of the School's Leadership Team.

Applicants will be advised of the outcome following completion of the selection process.
